Pteropcectria frondescentue, L. ; and Rivellia syngenesice, Fab. Although the only water near consisted of tiny streams and small horse or duck ponds, yet I obtained a series of Stratiomys chamakon on the flower-heads of angelica; and in the garden of the cottage, on the raspberries, Oxycera pulchella, Meig. , occurred, but was difficult to capture, it was so skittish. I obtained some very good Muscidae, Tachinidaa, and c, but these I have referred to elsewhere; and also the following among others--Oncomyia atra, F. , Physocephala rujipes, P. , Anthrax paniscus, Rossi, Dysmachus trigonus, Mg. , Chrysotoxum festivum, L. , Actina tibialis, Mg. , and a great number of other...
