

Excerpt: . . . principally at the larger end; but in four eggs from Wexford County, the entire surface is more or less thickly spotted with umber. In ground color, the eggs more nearly resemble those of the Catbird than any other species, but are not of so dark a shade of green. The Swainsons Thrush is the only one of the genus which lays spotted eggs. In the Fall migrations, the birds are found in the southern counties as late as October 1st, and a few stragglers occasionally even later. This Thrush is undoubtedly the most eccentric in its geographical range of any in its family famed for migrating. We learn that the Olive-back is known to Winter in Venezuela, while its northern haunts extend (probably) nearly to the Arctic circle. llylockhla vnaUiscte pallasi (Cab.) Ridgw. --Hermit Thrush, Rufus-tailed Thrush. Next to the Robin this is the first species to arrive in the Spring, and it occasionally appears as early as the last week in March, although the Hermits are rarely seen in any numbers till the middle of April. The species appear to migrate with great deliberation, and specimens can often be found loitering in the southern counties as late as May 10th. It is a common occurrence to observe numbers about the dooryards in villages, and even in sequestered favored locations in large cities during the latter part of April and early May.
