Most food plants are grown on farms, and so is cotton, from which more cloth is made than from any other substance. We have learned (p. 34) that the eastern half of our country is moist enough for farming, and we have also learned that the southern part is warm enough for cotton to grow. This map shows the cotton-growing region of the United States. Make a list of the eleven states in this region. Corn and other food plants are grown, but cotton is the most important crop of this southern section. More cotton is produced here than in all the rest of the world. Of all farm plants which the people of this country use for food, wheat, of which flour is made, is the most important. Great quantities of potatoes and other vegetables are also eaten. Much corn, oats, and hay are grown on the farms, but they are fed chiefly to animals--hogs, horses, and cattle. All of these food plants grow best in a cooler climate than that needed for cotton. cooler half of the moist eastern region. In this same northern section also most of the corn, oats, and hay are grown, and most of the hogs and cattle are raised. The northern section is thus the great food-growing region of the United States; it is one of the greatest food-growing...
