In the writer s experiments in which the effect of MgCl and MgSO4 was tried on CaCO3 at many concentrations, absolutely no trace of dolomite could be found in the residue when it was tested in the most careful manner with Lemberg s solution. To be sure, small transparent crystals were present which failed to take the stain and which suggested dolomite in several particulars, but these were insoluble even in hot, concentrated acids and the conclusion was forced that they represented quartz...



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
