

The author relates his memoirs in a beautifully written collection of short stories. Full of wry observations and entertaining characters, College Days: Tales from the Life of a Professor-errant captures the latter half of the Twentieth Century in finely tuned prose. Prepare for broad smiles of recognition and numerous laugh-out-loud moments in this stylized account of a life well lived. Many unique characters keep the pace moving: Palmer Calkin, who was willing to masturbate if it was a job requirement; Johnny Morris, who fashioned a tooth from a bright yellow toothbrush; Professor Krantz, who zealously hunted Bigfoot rather than grant money; Dorrie Lawrence, whose room served mainly as a kennel for her dog, Toto; Worthie Horr, whose name is so improbable that it seems contrived; Hannah C. He brings us in contact with student life - they coaxed the horse to the sixth floor, where they gave it a shot that killed it; the hazards of the professorial calling - Professor loses his rocks; DIY events that got out of hand and plain old-fashioned misjudgements.
