The major areas of U.S. concern in Paki- stan include: nuclear weapons and missile proliferation; regional stability; democratiza- tion and human rights; and economic reform and development. An ongoing Pakistan-India nuclear arms race, fueled by rivalry over Kash- mir, continues to be the focus of U.S. nonproliferation efforts in South Asia and a major issue in U.S. relations with both coun- tries. This attention intensified following nuclear tests by both India and Pakistan in May 1998. South Asia is viewed by some experts as one of the most likely prospects for use of such weapons. India has developed short- and intermediate-range missiles, and Pakistan has acquired short-range missiles from China and medium-range missiles from North Korea. India and Pakistan have fought three wars since 1947. The Pakistan-U.S. relationship, which dates from the mid-1950s, began as a security arrangement based on U.S. concern over Soviet expansion and Pakistan s fear of neigh- boring India. Cooperation reached its high point during the 1979-89 Soviet occupation of Afghanistan. U.S.-Pakistan ties have weak- ened since then. In October 1990, U.S. aid and arms...
