




Animals Upside Down: A Pull, Pop, Lift & Learn Book!

A fruit bat spreads its wings, a flamingo turns its head over to feed, and a hognosed snake doesn't just flip over and play dead, it can even bleed a little."The animals are all rendered with typically amazing accuracy from pieces of cut and torn paper.
