The Chinese government s new leadership has acknowledged that the country s economic growth will slow going forward due to a number of internal and external factors, likely to the range of 7-7.5 in the short- to mid-term, but has not reacted with stimulus measures through the first half of 2013.= Despite slowing GDP growth, which in 2012 was at the lowest level in 13 years, employment has remained stable, but weak profitability in certain sectors and continued external headwinds affecting export-oriented manufacturing may be cause for concern going forward. Inflation was at an annualized level of 2.6 in 2012, and has remained low through the first half of 2013. China s newly-installed economic policymakers have focused their rhetoric on...
