


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Make Your Own Clothes: Twenty Custom-fit Patterns to Sew (Paperback)

In addition, the custom measurements of each pattern can be adjusted before it s printed out. Moreover, a useful, ready-reference flaps fold out with information on what the pattern symbols mean and basic hand and machine stitches.
