This announcement concluded the largest and one of the most dramatic takeovers in history. DuPont initially offered an average price of \$79.52 for each share of Conoco, but revised this offer three times; the successful offer involved a cash payment of \$98 for 45 of Conoco and 1.7 shares of DuPont for each of the remaining Conoco shares. The value of this bid was \$7.54 billion making it the largest takeover in American business history. In addition to DuPont, two other firms bid for Conoco: Seagram made three offers and Mobil made three offers. This paper examines this takeover in detail. In particular, the stock price changes associated with each bid and other information releases are calculated. The effect of corporate takeovers on the stock prices of the participating firms has been studied extensively. Recent studies of mergers include Mandelker (1974), Ellert (1976), Dodd (1980) and Asquith (1981). The effects of tender offers on...
