It concentrates on providing simple illustrations of the statements and findings. Many of the facts are not new, but it is to my knowledge the first time that they have been gathered under one book and that the inter-linkage of the key issues has been produced. The book also establishes formally 1) important similarities between the workings of the United Nations and criminal organizations 2) the role of the United Nations in the power play between nations in securing geo-political interests (e.g. mining, oil) 3) the links between the United Nations and the Secret Services of powerful nations.
