



A Study of the Job Satisfaction of Teachers Among Government and Private Secondary Schools in Andhra Pradesh: Job Satisfaction, Secondary School Teachers,

It gained much importance due to its significance for the achievement of objectives of any organization. The purpose of this study was to explore job satisfaction of secondary school teachers working in the secondary schools at district Nalgonda, Andhra Pradesh The sample of 100 secondary school teachers were taken randomly from district Nalgonda for this study. The response rate was 100. In order to collect required data for the study, the SPSS was used to analyse the obtained data. Mean and Standard Deviation scores were calculated and t-test was also applied for the sake of comparison of job satisfaction of male-female and urban-rural teachers. The findings show that the secondary school teachers were slightly satisfied with the basic eight dimensions of a job i. e. ability utilization, advancement, education policies, independence, compensation, creativity, recognition and working condition. There was a significant difference of job satisfaction between male and female secondary school teachers. However no significant difference was found between the job satisfaction...



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
