

Railway Foot-Warmers. --It has previously been pointed out that the latent heat disengaged when a liquid solidifies causes the temperature to remain at the melting-point for a period of time depending upon the quantity of liquid and the rate at which heat is lost by radiation, etc. Advantage has been taken of this phenomenon in the construction of foot-warmers for use on railways, by filling a flat metal vessel with a substance which solidifies at a temperature conveniently warm to the feet. Sodium acetate, which sets at about 60 C, has been largely used for this purpose by the London and North Western and other railways. The solid is melted in the foot-warmers by steam, and after placing in the compartment the temperature falls gradually until the freezing point of the solid is reached, at which, owing to the large amount of substance used, it remains stationary for several hours.
