

The anthedia in our plant are unusually long (15 mm.), in this respect resembling other specimens from Arizona, near the northern limit of the species. The type specimens are described as having involucres only 4 lines (8 mm.) long. Apparently no species of Forophyllum has been collected in Nevada heretofore. Nicolletia occidentalis Gray in Frem. Second Rep. 316 (1815). Type locality on the banks of the Mohahvo river, growing in naked sands. Near Indian Wells (No. 1009). Heleninm bigelovii Gray, Pac. R. Rep. iv. 107 (1857). Type locality, swamps near Santa Rosa Creek, California. Near Mineral King (No. 1459) and in Sequoia Park (No. 2098), both in the Sierra. Nevada. Heleninm hoopesii Gray, Proc. Acad. Phil. 1863,65 (1863). Type locality, South: Park...
