Mazzeis volumes are somewhat carelessly arranged and the material was evidently prepared at different times, and hastily put together at last. This was the fashion of the day. The press, through the troubled hours that brought in the French Revolution, in the words of Lamartine in his History of the Girondists, no longer produced books; it had not the time. It contented itself first with pamphlets, and then with broadsides and newspaper articles. The work commences with an historical sketch of each of the old thirteen Colonies, and of the United States down to the last days of the old Confederation. Then follow the four Life and Works...
