Among these was Pizarro, who accomplished the conquest of Peru, then inhabited by people who had attained a considerable degree of civilization. Brazil, occupied by the Portuguese in 1549, fell successively under the dominion of Spain and Holland, but was finally recovered by Portugal in 1564. In the mean while, nearly the whole of the northern and western parts of South America had been overrun by the Spaniards....
