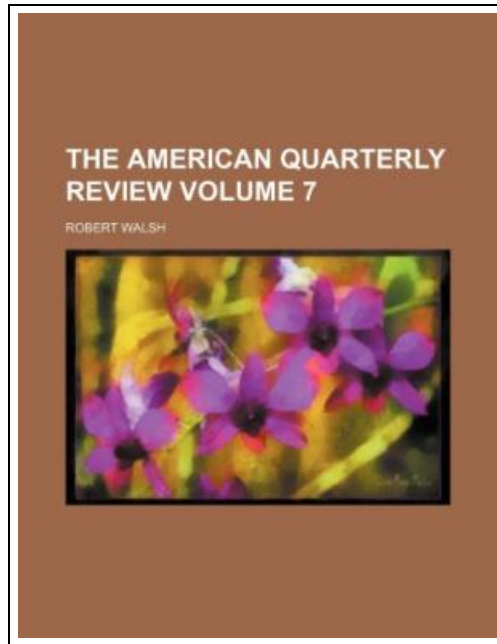

We have, in a previous number, given a rapid sketch of the order and subjects of the two first books of his *Mecanique Celeste*. To enter into a close investigation of the translation of Bowditch, would lead us into useless repetition. The XIIIth book of Laplace treats, in general, of the oscillations of the fluids that cover the planets. Of these, the most important to us are, the tides which take place in our own ocean. Newton first discovered the true theory of these oscillations, by including them in the general action of universal gravitation. The remark that the tides had some connexion with the diurnal and periodic motions of the moon, had been made by more than one ancient author, and Kepler had observed the tendency of the waters of the ocean towards the centres of the sun and moon. The last named author, however, as was observed on a former occasion, failed in discovering the true law followed by the attraction of gravitation, and he had not the methods which would have been necessary to reduce the law...
