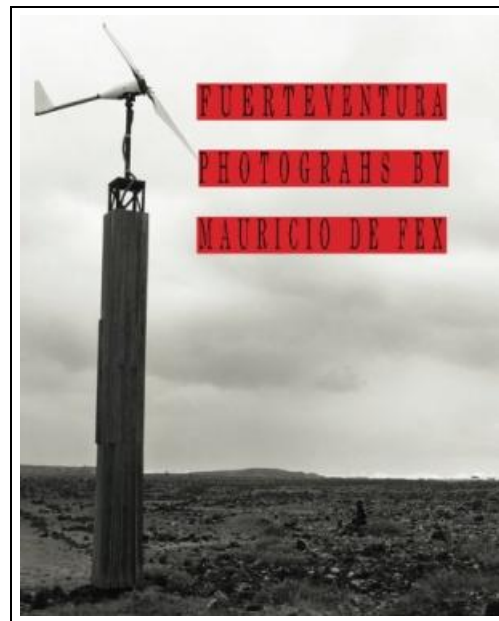

Moving to a different object of attention but keeping in mind that a landscape is just a feature on planet s face, this representational landscape photography uses a filter of impressionism, having as a result images that explore a less tangible side,...
