

In the next place, the course of their emigration, which led them to wherever the principle of, religious toleration had obtained a foothold, stamped their movement with almost universal significance. Large bodies of Huguenots thus settled them selves in various parts of Holland, Germany, Switzerland, Great Britain, America, etc., and through these settlements they have shaped, directly or indirectly, the character of modern civilization to a very important extent.
