

Mr. Wolfs article is reprinted in Appendix B. The Council passed a cordial vote of thanks to Mr. VVolf for the great service he had rendered by his interview with M. de Plehve. Mention may here be fittingly made of the concessions granted to Jews, only a few months before his assassination, by M. de Plehve, and since confirmed by the Tsar in a Ukase issued in September, in the direction of the attempt of residence within the Pale. These concessions, if loyally carried out, will to some extent relieve the congestion that has made...
