His declaration of fourfold restitution amounted to a pledge of his business honesty. He had evidently an intention to keep the rest of his possessions and continue in his occupation. At any rate, Jesus did not, in this case, demand the relinquishment of the whole of his property. He was entirely indifferent to the amount given. We see once more, then, that it was the personal attitude toward his teaching, the spirit to give to and help others, that Jesus appreciated. Bearing this principle in mind, it should be easy to find the real significance of Jesus reply to the rich young ruler. In spite of his faithful...
