Specification boxes for each aircraft provide at-a-glance information about the planes' country of origin, first flight, power, armament, size, weights and performance. Aircraft designed to attack and destroy other aircraft have existed almost as long as military aviation. This handbook traces the development of fighters from World War I to the present day, and highlights actions in which fighters played a crucial role. There are rare photographs of classic fighter aircraft, including the Bristol Fighter, Spitfire, P-51 Mustang, MiG-15, Hunter, Harrier and F-15 Eagle.
